## **Access Statement - Boating and canoeing**

The slipway is approx. 140m from the Visitor Centre.

The jetty with a hoist is approx. 185m from the Visitor Centre.

Some sections of both routes have section with gradients of 1 in 10.

Blue badge holders can park adjacent to the jetties and at the head of the slipway.

There is a steep slipway down to one launch point graded at 1 in 7 and 1 in 9.

There is a jetty equipped with a hoist location 140m from the Visitor Centre.

The gradient of the gangway down to the jetties varies with reservoir water level.

Access onto the jetties is controlled and supervised by NWL staff.

Some people will need assistance negotiating the slip way and accessing the gangway to the jetties.

The canoes provided are open Canadian canoes.
